I sat for my Kenya Certificate of Primary Education (KCPE) in 2006 and in 2007, joined B.L Tezza Complex Secondary School. This was made possible through the continued support of Dala Kiye. I sat for my Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE) in the year 2010 and managed to score grade C Plain.

After the results, I forwarded applications to a number of colleges within the country and fortunately enough, I got an offer to pursue a diploma course in education at Kisii University College. The course is scheduled to last for three years and has an overall cost of **2.757 Euro**. It is therefore my sincere plea to any well wisher to come forward and help me realize my dream by sponsoring me throughout the course.
